ISU TEAM NOTES

◆ Idaho State is under the direction of second-year coach Mike Kramer. Kramer guided the Bengals to a 2-9 record in his first season. Kramer is entering his 15th season as a coach in the Big Sky. Kramer has been a Big Sky Coach of the Year at Eastern Washington and Montana State.

◆ The Bengals are slated to return nine starters on offense and four on defense. In all, the Bengals return 37 letterwinners.

◆ Idaho State will once again play two FBS teams in 2012. The Bengals open with Air Force of the Mountain West

Conference and also take on Nebraska of the Big Ten on Sept. 22.

◆ ISU returns senior All-American wide receiver Rodrick Rumble, who in 2011 became the first Big Sky player to catch 100 passes in a season. Rumble caught 112 passes for 1,348 yards with nine touchdowns.

◆ Idaho State scored 204 points in 2011, an improvement from 2010 when the Bengals scored 172.

◆ A major goal of the 2012 Bengals will be to win a road game. Idaho State has not won away from Holt Arena since the 2006 season.

- ◆ KRAMER'S 79 VICTORIES RANKS FOURTH IN BIG SKY HISTORY. KRAMER IS ONE WIN BEHIND FORMER UM COACH BOBBY HAUCK FOR THIRD IN BIG SKY HISTORY
- ◆ KRAMER LED EWU TO A BIG SKY CHAMPIONSHIP IN 1997, AND LED MONTANA STATE TO TITLES IN 2002, 2003 AND 2005
- ◆ KRAMER IS ONE OF TWO COACHES AT THE DIVISION I LEVEL TO HAVE GUIDED THREE SCHOOLS IN THE SAME CONFERENCE. FORMER MONTANA STATE QB DENNIS ERICKSON (WASHINGTON STATE, OREGON STATE, ARIZONA STATE IN THE PAC-12) IS THE OTHER
