

2011 Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Championship Municipal Auditorium: March 8, 2011

Game Notes: No. 5 Iowa State 69, No. 12 Nebraska 61

With the win, Iowa State improves to 22-9 overall. ISU is now 7-1 in Big 12 Championship first round contests and 22-12 in overall Big 12 Championship games. ISU's 22 wins lead the Big 12.

With the loss, Nebraska fell to 13-18 overall. They dropped to 5-7 in Big 12 first round Big 12 Championship games and 8-15 in overall Big 12 Championship appearances.

Nebraska now holds a 40-36 lead in the all-time series between the two teams. Iowa State holds a 6-4 edge in Big 12 Championship games vs. Nebraska.

Iowa State head coach Bill Fennelly improved to 520-211 overall and 354-158 at ISU. Nebraska Head Coach Connie Yori dropped to 361-257 overall and 166-117 at NU.

lowa State extended its NCAA record streak of consecutive games with at least one three-pointer to 515.

lowa State's 13 3-pointers for the contest ranks fourth on the Big 12 Championship single-game record list. ISU holds nine of the top 11 single-game marks in tournament history and three of the top four.

ISU's Lauren Mansfield scored a career-high 23 points.

With her five 3-pointers, Kelsey Bolte moved into a third-place tie with Stacy Frese on the Iowa State career 3-point chart with 274. Her five 3-pointers mark the fifth time this season and the 15th time in her career she has hit 5+ from long range in a single contest.

Bolte and Mansfield each hit five 3-pointers, which each rank ninth on the individual single-game Big 12 Championship record list. Seven of the top 14 marks are held by ISU players.

ISU's Lauren Mansfield's five assists marks the 20th time this season she has dished 5+ in a contest. NU's Lindsey Moore's nine assists marks the 23rd time this season she has dished 5+ in a game.

With her 40 minutes in today's game, Lindsey Moore holds the record for most minutes played 1,164 at Nebraska in a single season. She passed Jina Johansen, who played 1,156 minutes in 2004-05.

Catheryn Redmon's six blocked shots are tied for third on the Big 12 Championship single-game record list.

With 16 points, Jordan Hooper moved into second place on the NU freshman single-season scoring chart. She also moved into fourth place on the Nebraska freshman rebound chart with seven rebounds today and 205 caroms this season. She is just the third NU freshman in school history to record 200+ boards.
