- McNeese will play its second Big 12 opponent on Saturday in Lincoln, NEB when the Cowboys tackle Nebraska...last year the Cowboys started their season with a 38-24 loss to Texas A&M of the Big 12....kickoff is scheduled for 11:30 a.m.

- **SERIESRECORD:** this is the first meeting between the two schools....they have played against each other on the baseball field (last spring in the McNeese Lake Area Classic.....Nebraska won 9-4)

- **NATIONAL POLLS:** Cowboys were ranked No. 2 to No. 1 Montana in last week's 1-AA polls....poll will be out on Monday afternoon....Nebraska fell out of this week's 1-A poll

- **COACHES....**McNeese is coached by **Tommy Tate** who is now in his third year with an 20-8 overall record, one conference championship and two post-season 1-AA playoff appearances....Cowboys are 4-0 this year with wins over Grambling (52-20), Youngstown State (28-13) and Western Kentucky (38-13), all ranked in the top 25 when they played, and a victory over 1-A Louisiana-Monroe (24-19)...Nebraska (3-2) is coached by **Frank Solich**, 45-11 and in his fifth year...the Huskers have defeated Arizona State (48-10), Troy State (31-16) and Utah State (44-13) this year while bowing to penn State (40-7) and Iowa State (36-14)

- **COWBOY KEY PLAYERS....**through four games this season McNeese's top players have been:....strong safety **Hadley Prince** (a Buck Buchanan award candidate) and has earned national and SLC player of the week honors...he leads team with 46 tackles...linebacker **Roderick Royal** was the SLC player of the week for the opening game win over Grambling and has 45 tackles as does linebacker Ryan Garrison...tailback **Vick King** leads the Cowboys in rushing with 354 yards and an average of 5.1 yards per carry....QB **Scott Pendarvis** is making 59.7 percent of his passes (37 of 62 for 515 yards and 4 tds)..WR **Jermaine Martin** has become McNeese's all-time leading pass receiver this year...he has 11 catches for 146 yards this year...**B. J. Sams** tops the Cowboys in all-purpose running with an average of 206.8 ypg....he has run two punts back for tds...**John Marino** has made 16 straight PATs and has made three of five field goals....five different players have intercepted passes for the Cowboys...guard **Mitch Sawyer**, center **Jason Davis** and tackle **Dwight Hudler** lead the Cowboy offensive line in grading

McNeese head coach Tommy Tate

- he's the second former McNeese football player to serve as the university's head coach...the first was the late Jack Doland who coached the Cowboys from 1970 to 1978, led them to a conference title and to bowl appearances in the Independence Bowl (1976 victory over Tulsa) and in the Grantland Rice Bowl (1971 loss to Tennessee State)...Doland was also the McNeese athletic director and went on to become the university's president and to serve as a state senator...he had played for the Cowboys in the 1940s when the school was a junior college and he went on to play for Tulane when it went to the Rose Bowl

- Tate played for Doland as he was a four year letterman from 1975 to 1978...he was a defensive back and earned all-conference academic honors

- in 1979 he stepped off the field and into the coaching box...in the summer of 1979 Doland was named the president of the university and Ernie Duplechin became the McNeese head coach, picking Tate to become his secondary coach

- Tate had served as a McNeese assistant coach for 20 years (one season was spent as the school's placement director)

- he was the assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 1999 and became head coach in 2000...he now has an 20-8 overall record and has the Cowboys undefeated at 4-0 this season....and ranked No. 2 in 1-AA



MARTIN GETS RECORD

Jermaine Martin has become McNeese State's all-time leading pass receiver. In the first game of the season he became the all-time leader for pass receptions and in the Cowboys' third game he took over

the leadership for yards catching passes. In his career with the Cowboys he has now caught 128 passes for 2,062 yards and nine touchdowns. He has moved into a tie for 10th on the all-time Southland Conference list for pass receivers.

This year he has caught 11 passes for 146 yards and a touchdown.

- **JERMAINE "Flea" MARTIN**

- has become McNeese's most prolific pass receiver....he now holds the school all-time record for both passes caught and pass receiving yardage.....he has caught 128 passes for a total of 2,062 yards.....he took over from former standout Terence Davis in both departments....Martin has also scored nine touchdowns in his career...the school record for that is 21 and is held by Davis

- **RADIO:** McNeese's games are carried this season over 99.5 (KXBG) with StructureX producing the show....George Swift is the producer of the show while Tom Hoefer will handling the play-by-play, Johnny Suydam will provide the color commentary and Ron Hayes handles halftime and post game

McNeese State is located in Lake Charles, LA, a city of 80,000 in the Southwest part of Louisiana. McNeese was established in 1939 as a junior college and a division of the Louisiana State University system. It later broke away becoming McNeese State. The school is named for John McNeese, the first superintendent of education in Calcasieu Parish (the parish in which Lake Charles is located). The school mascot is the Cowboy and was derived from the fact that John McNeese was also a cattle rancher and was renowned for making the first cattle drive across the Sabine River (the river that separates Louisiana and Texas).

McNeese is a coed univeristy with an enrollment of 8,000. Dr. Robert Hebert serves as the president and Sonny Watkins, a former McNeese player and coach, is the athletic director.

The schools of study for the university are: the Arts, Sciences, Engineering/Technology, Nursing, Education, Business and the Graduate School.

Among the many former McNeese State athletes who have gone on to professional stardom are: Joe Dumars in basketball (star with Detroit and now general manager of Detroit Pistons), Kavika Pittman (starting defensive end for Denver) and Zack Bronson (starting free safety for San Francisco) in football, Ray Fontenot in baseball (pitched for New York Yankees in Ron Guidry era) and Kevin Toth in track (nationally ranked shot putter)
