QUICKLY -- Kansas (3-6 overall, 1-4 Big 12) heads to Lincoln, Neb. to face No. 9 Associated Press Nebraska (8-1, 4-1) for the final time as Big 12 members. The game will kickoff at 6 p.m. and is available on FSN-Pay Per View.

- KU's win against Colorado last Saturday snapped an 11-game Big 12 losing streak and a four-game losing streak from this season.
- KU has lost seven straight road games dating back to its last win 34-7 at UTEP in September of 2009.
- KU will look to win consecutive games for the first time since opening 2009 with five straight wins.

COLORADO COMEBACK -- Last week's come-from-behind win against Colorado last Saturday was fairly notable. Trailing 45-17 eight seconds into the fourth quarter, the Jayhawks rallied for a 52-45 victory:

- KU's 35 four-quarter points were the second-most scored in a fourth quarter to win a game in NCAA history (36 by BYU in a 50-36 win vs. Washington State in 1990).
- The 28-point deficit was the largest KU has overcome to win, besting the 26-point comeback KU had at lowa State in 1992 (trailed 47-21 in the third and won 50-47).
- KU's 35 points in the fourth quarter were its most in a quarter in history (previous was 32 vs. Washington (Mo.) in 1923).
- KU's 52 points were its most in the last 25 games since beating Kansas State 52-21 in 2008.
- Colorado's 45 points were the most KU has allowed in a victory since defeating Iowa State 50-47 in 1992.
- KU's 52 points were more than it had scored in the previous four games combined (40).
- KU scored the game-winning touchdown with :52 left. The last time KU won a game in the final minute was when Todd Reesing hit Kerry Meier on a 26-yard touchdown pass with :27 left to beat Missouri in the final regular season game of 2008.

STOPPING AT 105 -- The nation's longest uninterrupted series will come to an end when Kansas and Nebraska meet for the 105th consecutive season Saturday. The series started in 1906 and has been played every year since, but will end in 2011 when Nebraska departs for the Big 10 Conference. That means the Minnesota vs. Wisconsin series (103 consecutive meetings before this year) will become the nation's longest. Kansas has been involved in two other of the nation's longest uninterrupted series in the fourth-longest (100 consecutive with Kansas State) and the fifth-longest (96 with Oklahoma, which ended in 1997).

KU-NU ONE OF MOST PLAYED -- KU and Nebraska have met 116 times overall for the third-most matchups in NCAA history trailing only Minnesota vs. Wisconsin (119 games) and Kansas vs. Missouri (118 games).

BACK-TO-BACK WITH DEPARTING MEMBERS -- Kansas is playing consecutive games against the two teams leaving the Big 12 Conference. The Jayhawks defeated Colorado, which is headed to the PAC-10, last week and will meet future Big 10 member Nebraska this Saturday.

DID YOU KNOW? -- Both KU head coach Turner Gill and offensive coordinator Chuck Long were Heisman Trophy finalists during their playing days. Gill was fourth in the 1983 balloting behind teammate and winner Mike Rozier, runner-up Steve Young and third-place finisher Doug Flutie. Long was the runner-up to Bo Jackson in 1985. Both later coached Heisman Trophy winners and finalists (Gill coached 1995 runner-up Tommie Frazier and 2001 winner Eric Crouch, while Long mentored 2000 runner-up Josh Heupel and 2003 winner and 2004 finalist Jason White).

DID YOU KNOW? -- The 10 full-time coaches at Kansas have a combined 187 seasons of coaching experience with 77 bowl appearances.

Head Coach Turner Gill

Turner Gill (North Texas, 1990) is in his first year as the head coach at Kansas after being hired on Dec. 13, 2009. Gill came to Lawrence after spending the previous four seasons as the head coach at Buffalo (2006-09) where he turned a down program into a conference champion in his third year. Gill was a highly successful player and assistant coach at Nebraska for a combined 18 seasons before spending one year with the Green Bay Packers and then taking over at Buffalo.

GILL HIGHLIGHTS

At Buffalo (Head Coach)

- * Coached Buffalo to its first winning record in 12 years with an 8-6 record in his third season at the school in 2008.
- * Produced 13 wins combined in 2007 (5-7) and 2008 (8-6) for a program which had won just 12 games in the previous eight seasons combined.
- * Led Buffalo to consecutive Mid-American Conference East Division titles with a share in 2007 and an outright title in 2008.
- * Buffalo won its first MAC Championship in school history and advanced to its first bowl game ever, playing in the International Bowl to conclude the 2008 season.
- * Named 2008 MAC Coach of the Year by The Sporting News.
- * Was a finalist for the Bear Bryant National College Football Coach of the Year in 2008.
- * Had eight players named all-MAC in 2008 after Buffalo had just seven players named in the first eight years the program was in the conference.
- * In 2008 produced Buffalo's first home field winning record since moving up to the FBS level ahead of the 1999 season.
- * Coached individual school record holders for passing, rushing and receiving yards.
- * Buffalo scored a school-record 424 points and threw for another school mark 3,326 yards in 2008 with Gill handling the play calling.

At Nebraska (Coach)

- * On coaching staff of three national championship teams at Nebraska in 1994, 1995 and 1997.
- * Was the position coach for Heisman winner quarterback Eric Crouch (2001) and Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award winner and Heisman runner-up Tommie Frazier (1995).

At Nebraska (Player)

- * Named Big Eight Conference All-Decade Team Quarterback for the 1980s and was inducted into the Nebraska Football Hall of Fame and the Orange Bowl Hall of Fame.
- * Was a three-time All-Big Eight Conference honoree, an All-America second-team selection and a Heisman Trophy finalist.
- * Nebraska posted a 28-2 record with Gill as the starting quarterback, including a perfect 20-0 mark in conference games.
- * Led Nebraska to three straight Orange Bowls.
- * Played one season of baseball at Nebraska and earned all-Big Eight conference honors.
- * Spent three seasons playing minor league baseball before getting into coaching football at the college level.

DID YOU KNOW? -- Turner Gill has won three games so far this season and only two of KU's last six coaches have won more games in their first year with the Jayhawks. Terry Allen was 5-6 in 1997 and Mike Gottfried was 4-6-1 in 1983. Other records include 3-8 by both Don Fambrough (1979) and Bob Valesente (1986), 2-10 by Mark Mangino (2002) and 1-10 by Glen Mason (1988).

This Week's Game

KU-NU SERIES -- In the nation's third-most played rivalry and longest uninterrupted series, Nebraska leads 90-23-3 all-time, including a 43-15-2 advantage in games played in Lincoln. KU has won more times in Lincoln (15) than it has in Lawrence (eight) in this series. After KU won back-to-back games in 1967 and 1968, Nebraska posted 36 consecutive victories against the Jayhawks. KU claimed a 40-15 victory in 2005 en route to winning two out of three. NU won an overtime contest in 2006 before KU posted a 76-39 victory in 2007. Since then NU has won both meetings - 45-35 in 2008 and 31-17 last year.

KU-NU LAST TIME -- After a low-scoring three quarters, a fourth-quarter scoring flurry led to a 31-17 Nebraska victory against Kansas on KU's senior day last season. Nebraska led 16-10 three minutes into the fourth quarter before KU QB Todd Reesing found Dezmon Briscoe on a 21-yard touchdown pass to give the Jayhawks a 17-16 lead with 7:34 left in the game. However, NU's Roy Helu had two touchdown runs to give Nebraska the victory. KU registered 335 yards, but Nebraska had 410. Todd Reesing was 19 of 41 for 236 yards passing, while Kerry Meier had 10 catches for 127 yards and Dezmon Briscoe four for 77. Toben Opurum ran 15 times for 43 yards, while Reesing added 42 yards on the ground. Huldon Tharp (13), Darrell Stuckey (11) and Chris Harris (10) led KU in tackles.

KU-NU LAST TIME IN LINCOLN - Tied at seven at the end of the first quarter, tied at 14 at halftime and with NU holding a narrow 24-21 lead after three quarters, Nebraska outscored Kansas 21-14 in the fourth quarter to post a 45-35 victory on a cold, windy day in Lincoln, Nov. 8, 2008. KU had 422 yards of offense, to Nebraska's 495. Todd Reesing was 15 of 30 for 304 yards with Dezmon Briscoe catching six of those passes for 176 yards. Jake Sharp ran 22 times for 90 yards and Darrell Stuckey had 15 tackles.

KU-NU CONNECTIONS -- KU HC Turner Gill was a QB at Nebraska from 1980-83, earning All-Big Eight honors three times, finishing his career with a 28-2 record as a starter, leading NU to three straight Orange Bowls, was a Heisman Trophy finalist in 1983 and was named the Big Eight Conference All-Decade QB. Gill was an assistant coach at Nebraska in 1990, 1992-2004... KU TE coach Aaron Stamn was a GA at Nebraska in 2004-05... KU DL coach Buddy Wyatt was a DL coach at Nebraska in 2007... KU has two players on its roster from the state of Nebraska in starting TE Tim Biere (Omaha/Westside HS) and backup DE Tyrone Sellers (McCook)... NU TE Kyler Reed is from Shawnee, Kan. (St. Thomas Aquinas)... NU DC Carl Pelini was a high school coach at Blue Valley and Winnetonka HS in the Kansas City area... KU RB coach Tim Beck was an assistant at Kansas in 2007... NU WR coach Ted Gilmore was born in Wichita and was an assistant at Kansas in 1999... NU LB coach Mike Ekeler was an assistant coach at Manhattan HS... NU DE coach John Papuchis was a graduate assistant at Kansas from 2001-03... KU on-campus recruiting coordinator Joe Dailey played QB at Nebraska before transferring to North Carolina.

THINGS TO LOOK FOR AGAINST NEBRASKA:

- WR Johnathan Wilson (1,427) needs 73 receiving yards to become the 14th player in KU history to record 1,500 receiving yards.
- Wilson (114) needs four receptions to pass Richard Estell (117) for eighth on the KU career receptions list.
- PK Jacob Branstetter (115) needs two PATs to pass Dan Eichloff (116) for second on the KU career PATs made list (Scott Webb is first at 159).
- DE Jake Laptad (19.5) needs one-half of sack to become the fifth player in KU history to record 20 career sacks. He needs one full sack to tie Ron Warner (20.5) for second on the KU career list (Algie Atkinson is the all-time record holder with 24).
- Laptad has recorded a sack in three straight games.
- QB Jordan Webb (1,114) needs 102 passing yards to set the KU season freshman passing yardage record held by Mario Kinsey, who threw for 1,215 yards in 2001.
- RB James Sims (three) needs one 100-yard rushing game to tie for the second-most 100-yard rushing games by a freshman in KU history (Kerwin Bell had six in 1980 and June Henley had four in 1983).
- WR Bradley McDougald has caught at least one pass in 11 straight games and in 20 of 21 career games.
- TE Tim Biere has caught at least one pass in 13 straight games.
- CB Chris Harris should make his team-high 39th career start.
- Four Jayhawks should make their 22nd consecutive starts in CB Chris Harris and OL Tanner Hawkinson, Brad Thorson and Sal Capra.

A KU win would...

- Be KU's third in six years against Nebraska.
- Be its second vs. a ranked team this year (defeated then No. 15 Georgia Tech).
- Give KU consecutive victories for the first time since winning the first 15 games of 2009.

A KU loss would...

- Be KU's 14th loss in its last 17 games after winning five straight to open 2009.
- Be less good than a win.

Kansas Team Notes

LAST TIME OUT -- As mentioned on page one, Kansas had a host of notables in its come-from-behind 52-45 victory against Colorado last Saturday. In addition to those notes on page one, here are a few more notes about the win:

- Freshman RB James Sims ran for a season-high 123 yards and a school-record tying four touchdowns, including the game winner with :52 left. Sims rushed for 75 yards and three touchdowns in the fourth quarter alone.
- Freshman NB Tyler Patmon scored KU's first defensive touchdown in the last 13 games when he returned a fumble 28 yards for a score. Patmon also added five tackles, an interception and three passes broken up.
- QB Quinn Mecham made his second consecutive start and responded by hitting 23 of 28 passes for 252 yards and two touchdowns with two interceptions.
- S Chris Harris recorded a season-high 11 tackles.
- DE Jake Laptad recorded a sack for the third straight game.
- KU registered two interceptions (Isiah Barfield and Tyler Patmon) after not picking off a pass in the previous five games.
- KU was 11 of 16 in third-down conversions in the game, including six of eight in the second half.
- KU scored touchdowns on each of its final five offensive possessions, as well as a defensive touchdown in that stretch
- After KU allowed Colorado to score on seven of its first eight possessions (six touchdowns, one field goal
 and one interception), the Buffaloes failed to score on their final four possessions (fumble, interception, punt,
 end of game).
- CU converted just one of four third downs in the second half.
- There were only three combined punts in the game (two by KU and one by CU).

OFFENSIVE NOTES -- KU ran for 201 yards against Colorado Saturday for its third 200-yard rushing game of the season - the most since 2007... Against Colorado KU rushed (201) and passed (252) for 200-plus yards in the same game for just the second time this season (237 rushing and 264 passing vs. New Mexico State)... KU also produced 200-plus rushing and passing yards against a Big 12 opponent for the first time since rushing for 212 and passing for 354 vs. lowa State in 2007... KU scored six offensive touchdowns against Colorado after combining for four in its previous four Big 12 games combined... KU's 52 points were more than its combined 40 in the previous four Big 12 games... KU punted just twice against Colorado Saturday, its fewest punts in the last 12 games... KU has 11 rushing and 10 passing touchdowns this season... KU has scored on all seven of its trips into the red zone in the last two games (five touchdowns and two field goals)... Against Colorado Saturday, KU had its first 20-plus yard touchdown plays in the last six games (28-yard run by James Sims and 38-yard catch by Johnathan Wilson).

DEFENSIVE NOTES -- KU recorded two interceptions against Colorado last Saturday to match its total of two in the first eight games combined... The KU defense came up with three turnovers against Colorado, its most in the last 13 games... KU has recorded five sacks in the last three games after getting four in the first six games combined... Six different players have recorded KU's nine sacks this season... Sixteen different Jayhawks have tackles for loss... KU allowed Colorado just 10 second-half points, the fewest scored against KU in the second half in five Big 12 games.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES – Kansas had averaged worse starting field position than its opponents in six of nine games this year... KU opponents have made 10 of 11 field goal attempts, while KU has made seven of 11... KU has made five of six field goal attempts (miss was a block) in the last three games after hitting just two of five in the first six games... P Alonso Rojas had recorded at least one 50-plus yard punt and landed at least one punt inside the opponent 20 in each of the first eight games before punting just twice against Colorado Saturday and not getting either.

LINEUP NOTES -- Here are a few lineup notes about the Jayhawks:

- Two weeks ago at Iowa State three Jayhawks made their first career starts (WR Erick McGriff, QB Quinn Mecham and CB Greg Brown), while DT John Williams made his first season start.
- This year 35 different players have started a game.
- Fifteen different players have made their first career start this year.
- In the last three weeks six different players have made their first start of the season.
- From 2007-09 Todd Reesing started 38 consecutive games at quarterback, but through eight games this season the Jayhawks started three different players at that position in Kale Pick, Jordan Webb and Quinn Mecham.
- KU has three players who have started on both offense and defense in their careers (D.J. Beshears, Toben Opurum and Daymond Patterson).

KU VS. RANKED TEAMS -- Kansas is 26-140-2 all time vs. Associated Press ranked teams, including a 28-25 win vs. then No. 15 Georgia Tech this season. KU is 9-83-2 vs. top-10 teams and its last victory against a top-10 team was its 24-21 win vs. No. 5 Virginia Tech in the 2008 Orange Bowl. The last time KU beat a top-10 team on the road was a 40-24 victory at No. 4 Colorado in 1995.

HARRIS MOVING UP DB TACKLE LIST -- CB Chris Harris recorded his 261st career tackle against Colorado Saturday. The senior needs 22 tackles in the final three games to tie for third on the KU career tackle list by a defensive back. LeRoy Irvin is the all-time leader with 347 stops, followed by Darrell Stuckey (295) and Tony Blevins and Paul Friday, who each had 283.

LAPTAD ON SACK LIST - DE Jake Laptad, who has recorded a sack in each of the last three games, has 19.5 for his career. He needs just one sack to tie Ron Warner (20.5) for second on the KU career list.

FRESHMEN QB AND RB -- Only twice in history has KU had freshmen lead the team in both rushing and passing in the same year. This year true freshman James Sims leads the team with 558 rushing yards, while redshirt freshman Jordan Webb has thrown for a team-best 1,114 yards. The first time freshmen led in both categories was 1945 (George Gear threw for 223 yards and Dick Bertuzzi ran for 360) and the second time was 1980 (Frank Seurer threw for 797 and Kerwin Bell ran for 1,114).

KU GRADUATES -- Four current Kansas players (all starters in the first two games) have already received their college degrees. This group includes OG Sal Capra (finance), S Olaitan Oguntodu (marketing and also finance), RB Angus Quigley (African and African-American studies) and OT Brad Thorson (business).

NON-SATURDAY GAMES -- Kansas played two non-Saturday games this season as the Jayhawks played at Southern Mississippi on Friday, Sept. 17 and hosted Kansas State on Thursday, Oct. 14. The last time KU played two non-Saturday regular season games in the same season was 1994 when the Jayhawks played at Houston on a Thursday (won) and on a Thursday vs. Kansas State (lost).

UNIFORM CHANGES -- There are a couple of small tweaks to the Kansas football uniforms this season. The red stripe which has been on the helmet has been taken off this year. Instead of names, a Jayhawk logo will be on the back of the jerseys. The last time KU players did not have names on their jerseys was 1981. In the season opener KU players wore blue tops with white pants for the first time since 2003 (had worn gray pants) and also wore white shoes for the first time since 1998. Against Texas A&M Kansas wore all blue uniforms for the first time since the Glen Mason era (1988-96).

UP NEXT -- Kansas will return home to host Oklahoma State Nov. 20.

DESHAUN SANDS - Redshirt freshman was team's offensive scout player of the year in 2009... Father Tony ran for a school record 396 yards vs. Missouri in 1991 and is KU's second-leading career rusher with 3,788 yards... Rushed for 30-plus yards as a reserve three times, including 35 last week against Colorado.

ANGUS QUIGLEY - Is in his sixth year in the program having missed 2005 and 2006 due to injuries... Recorded season highs in carries (16) and yards (70) with a touchdown against Kansas State... Gained 125 all-purpose yards (69 rushing, 56 receiving) against Iowa State... One of KU's five team captains.

WIDE RECEIVERS

DAYMOND PATTERSON - Has caught at least four passes in every game this year... Set a season high with eight catches last week against Colorado... Pulled in seven balls for 85 yards and one touchdown and a season-long of 32 against Georgia Tech... In first game of year against North Dakota State he had 66 receiving yards and 63 rushing yards...
