#### **STORYLINES**

Nevada, coming of back-to-back bowl appearances, is looking for a fast start to the 2007 season when it takes on No. 20/19 Nebraska on Saturday ... The Wolf Pack will be playing at Nebraska for the first time ever ... Nevada is looking to break a two-game losing streak (Boise State and Miami to end the 2006 season) ... The Wolf Pack has won its last two non-conference games (Northwestern and Colorado State in 2006) ... Nevada has also won its last two road games (at Idaho and at Louisiana Tech in 2006) ... Nevada is looking for its first victory in a season opener since 2003 ... Nevada coach Chris Ault is 14-8 in season openers in his 22-year coaching career ... The two teams have no common opponents this season...Last year, Nebraska beat WAC member Louisiana Tech 49-10 in Lincoln while Nevada beat Louisiana Tech 42-0 in Ruston, La. ... Nevada director of strength and conditioning John Archer spent seven years in the Nebraska strength program before coming to Reno ... Nevada has no players from the Cornhusker State while Nebraska has no players from Northern Nevada ... No members of Nevada's coaching staff have worked at Nevada.

#### IN THE SERIES WITH NEBRASKA

This is the first-ever meeting between the schools. In fact, Nevada has faced just one Big 12 Conference team in its 101-year football history – a 48-18 loss at Texas A&M in 1950 in College Station, Texas.

#### **SEASON OPENERS**

Nevada holds a 56-41-3 all-time record in season openers and coach Chris Ault is 14-8 in his 22-year career in season openers. Nevada is vying to end a three-game losing streak in season openers. The last time Nevada won an opener was in 2003 when it topped Southern Utah 24-23 at Mackay Stadium. The last time Nevada beat a Football Bowl Subdivision (Division I-A) team in an opener was in 1995 when the Ault-coached Pack beat Louisiana-Lafayette at home, 38-14.

## **WHO'S BACK**

The Wolf Pack returns 43 lettermen and 14 starters from the 2006 team that went 8-5 overall and 5-3 (T-3rd) in the Western Athletic Conference. The starters returning on offense are offensive linemen Charles Manu, Dominic Green and Greg Hall, and wide receivers Mike McCoy and Marko

#### **MEDIA SERVICES**

#### **Practice Schedule/Interview Policy**

Nevada student-athletes are available for interviews Monday and Tuesday before or after practice. Coaches are available Monday through Thursday, before or after practice. All interview arrangements should be made through the media services office. Nevada generally practices at 2:10 p.m. each day, but please check with the media services office for any changes to the weekly schedule. Players are not allowed to do out-of-town telephone interviews unless it is with their hometown newspaper.

#### **Postgame Interviews**

Postgame interviews for both the visitors and Nevada will be conducted in the media room on the first floor of Cashell Football Center. No Nevada student-athletes are to be interviewed on the field or en route to the locker room, and the Nevada locker room is closed. Following the NCAA's 10-minute cooling off period, the visiting coach and one or two players will be brought to the media room and followed by Nevada head coach Chris Ault and three to four requested players.

For road games, Nevada's locker room will be closed, but Ault and requested players will be available outside the visiting locker room or in the designated visiting media interview area after the NCAA's 10-minute cooling off period. No studentathletes are to be interviewed on the field or en route to the locker room.

#### **Media Work Area**

The media may work in the Mackay Stadium Press Box or in the media room in Cashell Football Center. A limited number of phone lines and ethernet connections are available in both locations. Wireless internet access is also available in the press box. Please see a member of the Nevada media services staff for the weekly password.

#### **Weekly Quarterback Club Luncheons**

Beginning Sept. 10, each Monday throughout the season (except during weeks when there is no game scheduled), the AAUN hosts a Quarterback Club Luncheon at the Peppermill Hotel/Casino at 11:30 a.m. Head coach Chris Ault and selected student-athletes will speak to the attendees and are available for additional interviews after lunch.

The Sept. 17 luncheon will be held in Carson City at Bully's Sports Bar and Grill and the Nov. 5 luncheon will be at Red's Little Waldorf Saloon in Reno. Lunch costs \$13.50.

#### **WAC Coaches Teleconference**

From Aug. 27 through Nov. 26, the WAC head football coaches wil take part in a conference call every Monday, starting at 9:30 a.m. Pacific Time. Each coach is allotted seven minutes with Chris Ault slated for 10:14 a.m. PT. Media wishing to participate should call (913) 312-9303, identify themselves and ask to participate in the WAC teleconference. There is also a same-day replay of the teleconference at 2 p.m. PT at (719) 457 0820.

### **Credentials and Parking**

All requests for credentials & parking passes for Wolf Pack football games should be made through the Nevada Media Services Office no later than 48 hours before game time.

Mitchell. The starters returning on defense are defensive linemen Matt Hines and Erics Clark, linebackers Jeremy Engstrom, Ezra Butler and Joshua Mauga and defensive backs Jonathon Amaya and Paul Pratt. Nevada also returns punter Zachary Whited and kicker Brett Jaekle.

The Wolf Pack returns its second- and third-leading rushers from a year ago in junior running back Luke Lippincott (94 carries, 456 yards) and sophomore Brandon Fragger (55 carries, 270 yards). Nevada also has back two of its top three receivers in Mitchell (39 catches, 493 yards) and McCoy (24 catches 357 yards). The top three scorers from the 2006 also return in Jaekle (71 points), McCoy (54 points) and Lippincott (54 points).

On defense, Nevada returns its top tackle in Butler (71 tackles) and four of its top seven from last year, including Mauga (56 tackles), Amaya (42 tackles) and Engstrom (41 tackles). Butler was the WAC leader in tackle for loss in 2006 with 17.5 for a loss of 84 yards. His average of 1.35 per game was 18th in the nation last year. He also recorded seven sacks in 2006 and is the leading returning in sacks in the WAC.

#### **TEAM CAPTAINS**

Senior offensive lineman Charles Manu, senior tight end Adam Bishop, senior nose guard Matt Hines and junior linebacker Joshua Mauga will serve as Nevada's team captains this season as voted on by their teammates. This is the second year that Hines has served as a captain and the second year in a row that a junior has been voted a captain, a rare occurrence for the Nevada program

#### SHUTOUT STREAK

Nevada has never been shutout as a member of Football Bowl Subdivision (Division I-A) and has not been shutout since Sept. 27, 1980, a streak of 317 games that is the longest in the nation. The last time Nevada was blanked was at Weber State, a 10-0 loss. That is the only shutout loss ever suffered by Hall of Fame coach Chris Ault. During the streak, Nevada has shutout eight opponents, the last being a 42-0 win over Louisiana Tech last year in Ruston, La.

#### **MACKAY IS BACK**

Since head coach Chris Ault returned to the sidelines prior to the 2004 season, Nevada has recorded a 15-3 record at Mackay Stadium and has only lost to two opponents (Washington State and Boise State). The Wolf Pack has gone 5-1 at home in the friendly confines each of the last three seasons.

Since then-quarterback Chris Ault led the Pack to a 17-13 victory over UC Santa Barbara on Oct. 1, 1966 in Nevada's first game in the facility, the Wolf Pack has turned in a 159-46-2 (.773) record at Mackay Stadium.

In his 22 years as Nevada's head coach, Ault has led the team to a 126-26-1 record at Mackay Stadium (.827). He has guided the Wolf Pack to 16 seasons with one loss or less at home, including four undefeated campaigns at Mackay Stadium (1976, 1985, 1990, 1994).

### **GETTING DEFENSIVE**

Nevada's defense emerged last season as one of the best in traditionally offensive Western Athletic Conference. The Wolf Pack, which returns seven starters on defense, pitched a pair of shutouts in 2006 and had three other victories in which it held its opponent to just one score. In Nevada's eight victories in 2006, the defense yielded just 257 yards per game, 68 fewer yards than its overall season total. Nevada was second in the WAC and 48th nationally in total defense in 2006 while finishing second in the league and 30th nationally in scoring defense.

#### MCCOY IS NEVADA'S TOUCHDOWN MAKER

Mike McCoy was a touchdown scoring machine in 2006. The then-sophomore was fourth on the team in receiving with 23 catches but nine of those scores (39.1 percent) of those catches went for touchdowns. McCoy tied with running back Luke Lippincott for the team lead in touchdowns last year. The scoring surge came after a freshman campaign in 2005 in which McCoy had just one touchdown among his 17 receptions.

#### **EXPOSURE**

Saturday's game will be the first of eight Nevada games that will be on television this year as ABC will provide the regional broadcast. Nevada will also appear on ESPN (vs. Boise State), ESPN2 (vs. New Mexico State and vs. Hawai`i), ESPN Regional Television (vs. Nicholls State) and the Big Ten Network (vs. Northwestern). The other two games that will be televised will be at Utah State and at San Jose State and those games will be on in Northern Nevada on MY 21 KAME-TV and on Comcast SportsNet West.

In August, The Wolf Pack Sports Network reached a three-year agreement with MY 21 KAME-

TV to televise Wolf Pack football and basketball games starting with the 2007-08 season and running through the 2009-10 season.

Nevada's flagship radio station, ESPN 630 AM, will broadcast all 12 regular-season games this year with Dan Gustin (play-by-play) and Bill Daniel (analyst) calling the action. When Gustin is handling TV duties, Dan Marchand will handle the play-by-play on the radio. Fans can watch live video streaming of non-televised WAC games on the internet on a pay-per-view basis this season by logging on to www.nevadawolfpack.com

#### **NEVADA PICKED THIRD/FOURTH IN THE WAC PRESEASON POLLS**

#### **AULT MOVING UP CAREER VICTORIES LISTS**

Among active coaches with five years of Division I-A experience, College Football Hall of Fame inductee Chris Ault ranks fifth in career victories with 185. In his third stint as the head coach of the Wolf Pack, Ault now holds a 185-78-1 record in 22 years as a head coach, all at Nevada.

The winningest coach in school history, Ault was named the WAC Coach of the Year in 2005 for his efforts in leading the Wolf Pack to a share of the league title and the school's first bowl appearance (Sheraton Hawaii Bowl) in nine years. During his tenure, Ault has won eight conference championships and taken Nevada to postseason play ten times (four bowl games).

#### **AULT'S CONTRACT EXTENDED THROUGH 2011 SEASON**

On Aug. 16 the Nevada Board of Regents approved a contract extension for head football coach Chris Ault through the 2011 season. Ault, a Nevada graduate who is a member of the College Football Hall of Fame, has a career record of 185-78-1 in 22 years as a head coach, all at Nevada. He is 22-15 in his third stint as the Wolf Pack's coach and has taken the team to back-to-back bowl appearances over the past two seasons. He is the fifth winningest active coaching in Division I.

## MATT HINES NAMED TO BRONKO NAGURSKI & OUTLAND TROPHY WATCH LISTS

Nevada senior Matt Hines has been named to the preseason watch lists for the Bronko Nagurski Trophy and the Outland Trophy, two of the most prestigious awards in college football, the Football Writers Association of America announced this summer.

A 6-1, 285-pound defensive tackle from Modesto, Calif., Hines is one of 50 players on the watch list for the Bronko Nagurski Trophy, which is annually awarded to the best defensive player in college football and is sponsored by the Charlotte Touchdown Club. The FWAA All-America Committee will select the Bronko Nagurski winner from the association's 11-man All-America defensive team in November. The FWAA will also select a Bronko Nagurski National Defensive Player of the Week beginning with games on Sept. 1 through mid-November, while the Charlotte Touchdown Club will host the 2007 presentation banquet on Monday, Dec. 3.

The Bronko Nagurski Trophy is awarded in memory of Nagurski, an All-America lineman at Minnesota in 1927-29 and star for the Chicago Bears in the 1930s. Ohio State linebacker James Laurinaitis won the 2006 Bronko Nagurski Trophy.

Hines is also one of 41 linemen from around the country nominated for consideration for the Outland Trophy, which has been awarded to the best interior lineman in college football since 1946. Tackles, guards and centers are eligible for consideration for the award, and additional candidates can be added throughout the season.

The FWAA's All-America Committee will select the Outland Trophy finalists and winner. The winner of the 2007 Outland Trophy will be announced on Dec. 6 at the ESPN Home Depot College Football Awards Show in Orlando, Fla. The presentation banquet, sponsored by the Greater Omaha Sports Committee, will be held in January of 2008 in Omaha, Neb.

The Outland Trophy is named after the late John Outland, a lineman at Pennsylvania at the turn of the century. Wisconsin offensive lineman Joe Thomas won the award in 2006.

#### DOMINIC GREEN NAMED TO RIMINGTON TROPHY WATCH LIST

Nevada junior Dominic Green has been named to the spring watch list for the Dave Rimington Trophy, which is annually presented to the most outstanding center in college football. The watch list consists of 46 of college football's top centers, making it the largest watch list in the history of the award. The list will be updated once prior to the beginning of the season and features 23 seniors, 18 juniors and five sophomores.

A 6-3, 295-pound offensive lineman out of Jesuit High School in Sacramento, Calif., Green has started every game in his career at Nevada. He earned second-team All-Western Athletic Conference honors after starting all 13 games at tackle last season. He also started all 12 contests as a true freshman in 2005, including eight at center and four at guard. In 2007, Green will return to the center position. He will likely miss the first two games of the season with a broken foot suffered before the opening of fall camp.

#### **BUTLER ON WATCH LIST FOR LOMARDI AWARD**

Nevada senior outside linebacker Ezra Butler has been named to the watch list for the Rotary Lombardi Award. The 38th annual Rotary Lombardi Award, presented by Wachovia, honoring the top lineman in college football and benefiting the American Cancer Society, will be presented in Houston on December 5 at the Hilton Americas Hotel.

Butler, a 6-2, 248-pounder who was Nevada's leading tackler last season, is one of 65 players on the watch list. He was a first-team All-WAC selection last year, leading the conference in tackles for loss and finishing 18th in the nation in that statistic. He also recorded 7.5 sacks in 2006 and is the WAC's leading returning sackman.

#### **UP NEXT**

The Wolf Pack will hit the road again next week as it travels to Evanston, Ill., to face Northwestern. This marks the second straight season that Nevada has played the Big Ten Conference member. Last year, in the first ever meeting between the schools, Nevada took a 31-21 victory on national television.
