POST-GAME NOTES & QUOTES

Tom Osborne, Nebraska - "I think Hawaii has done really well. They were impressive, they played awfully hard, they scrambled and they were aggressive. They've done a tremendous job this game--there's no comparison between this team and the ones we've played five or six times before.

"They had a very good plan, they did what they had to do. You know they had to take chances and they gambled at the right time.

"I think our players have a great deal of respect for them, and I told those players that this may have been our finest win. The Oklahoma game was a big one and a lot of people were going to say that we just came over here to go to sleep but no, I think we played a very good football ~~game~~ team. We had to play great football to overcome ~~that~~ team. As far as I'm concerned, we had to play really well to overcome them.

"We talked to them during halftime and we told them that they're just not playing badly--we tried to give them a shot in the arm. And I think that had a lot of effect. We got them to play hard and we told them we're just going to have to win this thing."

Turner Gill, quarterback - "I just think this team was great, they played really well and it took a lot to beat them.

"Their defense was jumping around a lot so we just had to run the ball one, two, three on a quick count. Before the game started we knew that Hawaii was going to be a good team."

Dave Rimington - "I have a lot of respect for him. He's a good nose guard. When we came into this game, Tomey said something about his secret weapon, and I found out that it was Noga and another back and their play was excellent. I like to see the smaller guys get a chance (Noga). He's an aggressive player and he really knows his stuff. He should be a good one."
