THE GAME • Western Michigan football kicks off its 103rd season at Nebraska, marking the first time in program history the Broncos open a season with an opponent from the Big 12. It is the fourth-straight season WMU will open its season on the road and fourth time in as many seasons Western Michigan opens the season with a team from a BCS Conference.

Since 2005, WMU has opened with teams from the ACC (Virginia), Big Ten (Indiana), Big East (West Virginia) and now the Big 12 (Nebraska). The Broncos also opened the 1999 season against an SEC team (Florida), meaning WMU is Pac-10 team away from opening a season with schools from each BCS conference.

TELEVISION • The 2008 season opener will air live on Fox Sports Network on a pay-per-view basis. Suggested retail price for residential purchase is \$29.95. Big 12 Special Order Sports, Fox Sports Net's pay-per-view division, will produce and distribute the telecast. The game is being televised on pay-per-view because it was not selected for over-the-air broadcast or cable television coverage. Fans in Michigan with DirecTV or Dish Network should be able to see the game at no extra charge as a part of the sports package. Please check for exact channel listings. Veteran college football announcers Ron Thulin (play-by-play) and Richard Baldinger (analyst) will call the action, with FSN's Stacy Paetz as sideline reporter.

RADIO • This and all Western Michigan football games will be broadcast live on the Bronco Radio Network and its new flagship station, WZUU - 92.5 FM. Robin Hook (play-by-play), calling WMU football games in his 25th season, and Monty Porter (analysis) will have the call as they have together for the past 10 seasons.

WEB SITE • WMU home football games (not televised by the ESPN family of networks) can be seen live via the official athletics web site (www.wmubroncos.com) by subscribing

to Bronco Insider, which can be found on the home page of the site. You are able to listen to each Bronco football game on the Internet by signing up with Yahoo Sports through the link at the bottom of the home page. Live Stats are available for FREE for all Bronco home games by clicking the link atop the home football page. Live Stats for the game against Nebraska will also be available on our site as well.

SERIES IN BRIEF • This will be the first time Western Michigan and Nebraska take the field against one another. The Broncos are 1-3-0 all-time against teams from the Big 12 with its lone win coming against Iowa State, 23-19, on Sept. 17, 1994 in Ames, Iowa.

THE COACHES • Bill Cubit (Delaware, 1975) begins his third season as the head coach of Western Michigan. He is 20-16 overall (.556), 11-5 at Waldo Stadium (.688), at Western Michigan and led the Broncos to their first bowl game since 1988 in 2006. Bo Pelini (Ohio State, 1990) takes over the reigns at Nebraska after serving as LSU's defensive coordinator (2005-07). He was at Nebraska previously (2003) for one season. He served as the interim head coach against Michigan State in the Alamo Bowl, a 17-3 win.

UP NEXT • Western Michigan will host Mid-American Conference West Division rival Northern Illinois in its home opener on Sept. 6. The Broncos will celebrate their 16th year of CommUniverCity Night leading up to the game against the Huskies.

GAME 1 — WESTERN MICHIGAN AT NEBRASKA — GAME NOTES

OPENING ACT • Western Michigan has began a season on the road 33 times in its 102-year history and the Broncos have a record of 12-21 during those games. WMU's first road opener (based on home and away games being recorded) came on Oct 8, 1927, a 18-6 loss to Lombard (Ill.).

THE TIES THAT BIND • The Broncos' first-year wide receivers coach Mike Grant will be have a homecoming of sorts when WMU takes on Nebraska in the 2008 season opener. Grant was a three-year letterwinner as a quarterback at Nebraska from 1988-92. He played under former head coach and current Huskers athletic director Tom Osborne.



LET'S KEEP IT GOING • Western Michigan closed out a season with back-to-back wins for the first time since 1998 after closing out 2007 with wins at Iowa (28-19) and against Temple (16-3). WMU last accomplished the feat by defeating Ball State, 24-23, and Bowling Green, 56-27.

The last time the Broncos ended a season with at least two-straight wins and won in the season opener the following year was also 1998. Following the 1997 campaign, when WMU ripped off six-straight wins to close out the season, the Broncos opened 1998 with a 37-23 win over Northern Illinois.

STOP ... THIEF! • The Bronco defense has built a reputation for taking things that don't belong to them on the football field. Under head coach Bill Cubit, Western Michigan has registered 93 take aways over the past three seasons, including 49 interceptions. The Broncos led the nation in picks in 2006 with 24, recording 34 take aways during the season. Cubit's first season (2005) saw WMU intercept the ball or recover a fumble 35 times.

WMU's active interception leader is Louis Delmas with eight picks to his credit. Fellow senior C.J. Wilson holds the school record for most interceptions returned for touchdowns. He has recorded one in each of the last three seasons. His last came against Big 12 opponent Missouri in 2007.

The returning starting secondary of E.J. Biggers, Delmas, Londen Fryar and Wilson have collectively registered 25 of the 49 interceptions for Western Michigan over the past three seasons.

BRIGHT LIGHTS • Western Michigan will play in four night games in 2008, five if it earns a berth in the Mid-American Conference championship game. The Broncos open the season under the lights in Lincoln, Neb. WMU went 2-3 in night games a season ago.

DREAMS OF OUR FATHERS • Every father hopes his son or daughter finds success in life and Irving Fryar is no different. The five-time Pro Bowl selection, and Nebraska alumn, played from 1984 to 2000 for New England, Miami, Philadelphia and Washington has seen his son, Londen, find success on the football field at Western Michigan.

The younger Fryar, a two-time First Team All-MAC selection and 2008 Bronko Nagurski and Jim Thorpe Award Watch Lists, had a school-record six pass deflections

STEP BY STEP • Multiple Broncos on offense, defense and special teams have the chance to move upward on career record lists in 2008.

WELL ISN'T THAT SPECIAL • Western Michigan will have two new starters on special teams in 2008. Redshirt freshman punter Ben Armer and true freshman John Potter will each make their collegiate debut against Nebraska.

WITHIN REACH • There were not many passes that were out of the reach of Jamarko Simmons in 2007 and the top of the record book is now also in his reach. A duplication of his junior season (84 rec., 980 yards) would give him the career receptions record and place him in third on the career receiving yards list.

HIGH AND TIGHT • The tight end unit at Western Michigan has accounted for 32 of the 73 receiving touchdowns over the past three seasons, which is 43.8 percent. The unit has not accounted for anything lower than 40 percent in any of the seasons.

ONE AND (NOT) DONE • Senior linebacker Boston McCornell played in his first year of Division I-FBS football in 2007 after transferring from Georgia Military College. McCornell led the team in tackles with 99 (the most by a Bronco since 2003) and recorded his first collegiate interception for a TD in his fourth game of the season.

BCS SUCCESS • Western Michigan has experienced success against teams from BCS conferences under Bill Cubit. The Broncos defeated Virginia in 2006 and Iowa last season.

Certain Broncos have had statistical success as well. Jamarko Simmons registered 14 receptions for 158 yards against West Virginia. Tim Hiller had a pair of 300-yard passing games against Indiana and Iowa and Brandon West broke a school and MAC record for all-purpose yards in a game against the Hoosiers. He returned a kick off 98 yards for a score as well.

LEAVING ON A JET PLANE • The Nebraska game is the first of four road trips where Western Michigan will fly to its destination. In fact, the Broncos will not take a bus to an opponent's campus until their Oct. 18 meeting with MAC West rival Central Michigan. WMU will fly approximately 7,410.1 miles this season.

WHAT'S THE SCORE • Western Michigan allowed 28.9 points per game in 2007 but that average dropped to 23.2 in MAC games. WMU allowed the opposition on average 18.75 points in its final four games of the season, including allowing just three points in its season finale against Temple. The Broncos held their opponents under 20 points five times in 2007.

HEAD OF THE CLASS • This past season, Tim Hiller was one of only four Division I-FBS quarterbacks to complete the fall semester with a 4.0 GPA. Only three of those signal callers, including Hiller, retained a 4.0

GPA throughout the 2007-08 academic year.

Hiller completed his undergraduate course work during the second summer semester in August and will begin work on his master's degree this fall.

QUICK STRIKABILITY • Western Michigan has the ability to score quickly. The Broncos orchestrated 10 drives of five plays or less in 2007.

THAT WAS QUICK • Tim Hiller has orchestrated three one-play drives in his career and all came in the same game and each came one after the other. Hiller threw touchdowns on the first play of three-straight drives in a 31-24 win over Central Michigan on Nov. 12, 2005.

WELL BALANCED • The Bronco football team is quite balanced across its classes. WMU has 22 seniors, 15 juniors and 22 sophomores to go along with 12 redshirt freshmen and 24 members of the 2008 recruiting class. Western Michigan added eight freshmen walk-ons and one late signee prior to preseason camp.

SACK MASTERS • The Broncos led in team sacks five times during the 2007 season and boasted a 4-1 record in such contests. Conversely, when the opponent managed more team sacks, WMU had a 1-4 mark.

THE SPACE BETWEEN • WMU's smallest span of time between scoring drives came in its rivalry game against Central Michigan on Nov. 6. The Broncos scored fourth-quarter touchdowns 33 seconds apart. Conversely, the Broncos' largest span between scores occurred at Eastern Michigan on Oct. 27, scoring a safety in the first quarter and remaining scoreless the remaining 45:25 of the game.

TACKLE BOX • Six of Western Michigan's top seven tacklers from 2007 return in 2008 with each collecting 50 or more stops.

MOVERS AND SHAKERS • Western Michigan welcomed four new coaches to its staff prior to the 2008 season.

Mike Grant - Grant came to WMU after spending a season at Southern Miss and following nine season at Iowa State.

Rick Kravitz - Kravitz comes to WMU after spending a season as the defensive coordinator at Memphis. He brings 23 years of experience to Kalamazoo.

Mike Sabock - Sabock spent 24 seasons with MAC rival Northern Illinois under legendary head coach Joe Novak.

Ryan Cubit - Cubit, finishing graduate school, is in his first season with the Broncos as a member of the coaching staff, working with WMU's quarterbacks.

FEELING LUCKY • Nebraska running back Marlon Lucky was a large part of the Huskers' offense in 2007. He led his team in rushing with 1,019 yards and receiving with 705 yards. He also led Nebraska in scoring with 12 touchdowns (nine rushing, three receiving) and added a successful two-point conversion try to finish with 74 points.

REMEMBERING YOUR FIRST TIME ... AGAIN • The 2008 season opener for head coach Bo Pelini will be his first regular season game as a head coach but not his first as a head coach. Pelini led Nebraska to a win over Michigan State, 17-3, in the 2003 Alamo Bowl.

NEBRASKA 2008 SCHEDULE • Western Michigan is one of three opponents from non-BCS conferences (San Jose State, New Mexico State) on Nebraska's schedule. The Huskers do not play a game away from Memorial Stadium until their Oct. 11 meeting at Texas Tech in Lubbock, Texas.

SILVER ANNIVERSARY • The Voice of Bronco Athletics, Robin Hook, is entering his 25th year of calling Western Michigan games on the Bronco Radio Network. He has called two of the three postseason bowl games in WMU football history.

THE HOST WITH MOST • Western Michigan football will host a home game at Ford Field for the first time when the Broncos take on Illinois (currently ranked No. 19) on Nov. 8. The Broncos will continue the relationship with the Big Ten in 2009 when Michigan State is scheduled to take the field against WMU at the home of Detroit Lions.

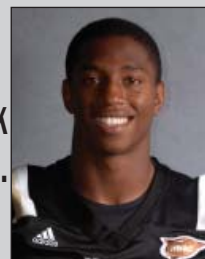
